

(Ages 6 and over)

- 1. The individual must have a documented qualifying diagnosis of a developmental disability made by a qualified professional.
- 2. The individual must have a physical or mental impairment other than a mental illness.
- 3. The onset of the disability must be documented as occurring prior to the age of 22.
- 4. The individual's disability must be likely to continue indefinitely.
