## **Tips for Classroom Inclusion**

With the school year back in full swing, Auglaize DD's SPEAK (Supporting and Promoting Empowerment & Achievement through Kindness) committee has tips to help make your classroom more inclusive for students with disabilities!

- 1. Disability Awareness Groups: Create groups where students learn about various disabilities, their impact, and respectful interaction with people who have disabilities. (We have a great handout for this!) Invite guest speakers, such as disability advocates or individuals with disabilities, who can share their experiences. (SPEAK can help with this too!)
- 2. Sensory Simulations: Set up stations to simulate sensory disabilities (e.g., blindness or deafness). Students can try activities blindfolded or with earplugs to understand the challenges faced by individuals with sensory disabilities.
- 3. Assistive Technology Showcase: Display assistive technologies like screen readers, communication devices, and adaptive equipment. Encourage students to interact with these tools to understand their functionality and how students with disabilities use these tools in their everyday lives.
- 4. Inclusive Sports Activities: Offer inclusive sports activities such as wheelchair basketball or seated volleyball to allow students with and without disabilities to participate together.
- 5. Disability Awareness Art Projects: Engage students in creating artwork, posters, or murals that celebrate disability awareness and promote inclusivity. Display these artworks around the school.
- 6. Introduce Disability-Inclusive Literature: Include books or stories featuring characters with disabilities in the curriculum during Disability Awareness Week.
