

Eligibility for Auglaize County Board of Developmental Disabilities Services



Ages 0-3 (Early Intervention)

Eligibility is determined through one of the following:

- A confirmed, diagnosed condition that could result in a delay.
- A delay as shown through an evaluation tool.
- Informed clinical opinion (ICO) of the evaluation team.

The child is assessed through play in the following areas: Gross/Fine Motor Movement, Receptive Communication/Expressive Communication, Social-Emotional Development, Sensory Development, Adaptive Behaviors, Cognition, Feeding, Vision, Hearing



Ages 3-5

• The child must have a qualifying diagnosis, established risk of delay, or qualify for an Individual Education Program (IEP) through his/her local school district, with at least two developmental concerns in the following areas: adaptive, cognitive, communication, social & emotional domains, fine & gross motor skills, vison, and hearing



Ages 6+

- The individual must have a documented qualifying diagnosis of a developmental disability made by a qualified professional.
- The individual must have a physical or mental impairment other than mental illness.
- The onset of the disability must be documented as occurring prior to the age of 22.
- The individual's disability must be likely to continue indefinitely.
- The individual must have substantial function limitations in at least 3 of the following areas: self care, receptive and expressive language, mobility, learning, self direction, capacity for independent living, and economic self-sufficiency (ages 16+)

COEDI (ages 6 to 15): Children's Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument **OEDI** (ages 16 and over): Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument

Applicants must reside or plan to reside in Auglaize County. (NOTE: Eligibility cannot be finalized until residency is established.)
